

Composting Toilet Manual



Wee:

For wee it's like a normal toilet. No filter required, no flap or crank required. Just note these two differences:



Guys - sit down to wee



Ladies - Put toilet paper in the rubbish bin please, not in the toilet.



Poo:

1. Place 1 coffee filter down on the flap, with the fold positioned away from the urine-draining holes.
2. Make your deposit.
3. Stand up and open the flap with the black toggle on left. Make sure the filter and the poo go straight down into the poo tank. If you have more than 1 toilet paper wipe, put extras in the rubbish bin.
4. Shut the flap.
5. Turn the crank on the right 1/2 a turn.
6. Wipe any skids with toilet paper and deposit in the poo tank.
7. Wash your hands & celebrate!



Menstruation:

Blood in toilet bowl:

Close flap.

Tip a cup of water onto the blood so that it washes down into the wee tank.

Wipe bowl with toilet paper if necessary.

Cup Users:

Empty cup in the bath and wash down with water.





DO:

- Close the lid between uses.
- Keep the exhaust fan on.
- Place disposable menstrual products in the rubbish bin in the kitchen.
- Develop a friendly relationship with your wees and poos!
- Feel good about returning your waste to the earth without using drinking water.



DO NOT:

- Use more than 1 filter at a time or pile loads of toilet paper into the poo tank.
- Use filters for wees.
- Get anything stuck in the flap mechanism.
- Put anything random in the poo tank.
- Get wee or other liquids in the poo tank.
- Get cleaning products on the poo tank.
